Subject: Early Dismissal Calendar Final Revision

I would recommend dropping the following Early Release Days after conversations with Chiara and John.

Delete August date: 8/24 (school began and PD including data review and testing information and training given. August and September are the months all testing must be done)

Delete September dates: 9/7 and 9/21 (By dropping both August and September early release dates the testing window is open and there is time to get into a strong instruction routine and get behaviors in check.)

Delete October 5 (19th is needed since report cards go home the 24th, that is always an adventure. You will probably be preparing for parent conferences on that day also as you will have all testing results plus you will know the classroom performance of students)

Delete November Early Release (The month is chopped by holidays, and you will want as much consistent instruction as it will be lost the closer to Christmas you get.)

Keep the December 7 early release to review data to set Winter Boot Camp and make sure tutorials are set and ready to begin immediately upon return to school in January.

Delete all January Early Release (Teachers return without students on the 4th and have a full day of PD, review of data and complete report cards for distribution on the 17th. I would try to keep January as disruption free as possible to reestablish routines.)

Delete February 1 (Keep the 15th for data review and Progress Reports)

Delete March 1 (March is very broken with spring break. The 22nd is needed for report cards and data chats awhile tutorials are underway to see if scholars need to be added and review results of Academic Boot Camp over Spring Break.)

Delete April 5 (The 19th will be final training for progress monitoring as well as review of IEPs to make sure that accommodations are accurate and in place for the progress monitoring as spring is a time when many IEPs are updated, and these updates may include new accommodations students are entitled to have.)

Delete all May early release dates (May is the month for PM3. All PM will be via computer and our availability of computers will determine how much time will be needed to complete testing. An early release day would break momentum of testing.)

This will cut 14 early release days from the calendar, leaving 5 early release days on the calendar.

Principals Report: Principal Ajo showed how ACCA outperformed the Osceola County School District in every cell that was evaluated. She presented her situation regarding continuing as principal of the school and introduced Ms. Kinlan as the person who should take her position. Leslie Bolte indicated that her work with Kinlan showed all her attributes as a teacher, task master and being able to accomplish all tasks she was responsible for and also led our Civics class to an 85% proficiency (Twenty points higher than the school district.) Kinlan provided her background as a teacher for 20 years in the public, private and now charter school areas. Noted her familiarity with classical education and committed to building the classical structure within ACCA.

PSP Report: Jennifer Levy noted that no elections were held at the end of year. They are planning to have elections at the beginning of this year. One area of focus is to motivate the parents to form a new board and be active at the school.
